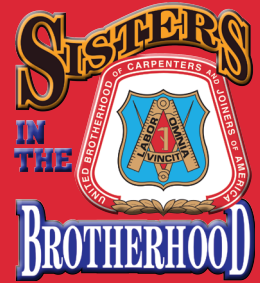


WOMEN . . . NEED A CAREER? JOBS DON'T HAVE A GENDER IN THE CARPENTERS UNION!
